Overview

Background

- Information disclosure regarding state and regional revenues obtained from extractive industries is specifically regulated in Presidential Regulation 26/2010
- Extractive industry data portal is one of the requirements of international EITI global standards based on open data
- A platform that accommodates data availability in physical EITI reports into digital access data
- A data warehouse that combines all revenues and state revenues obtained from extractive industries through several datasets of the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources, Ministry of Finance, SKK Migas, Regional Governments and Companies

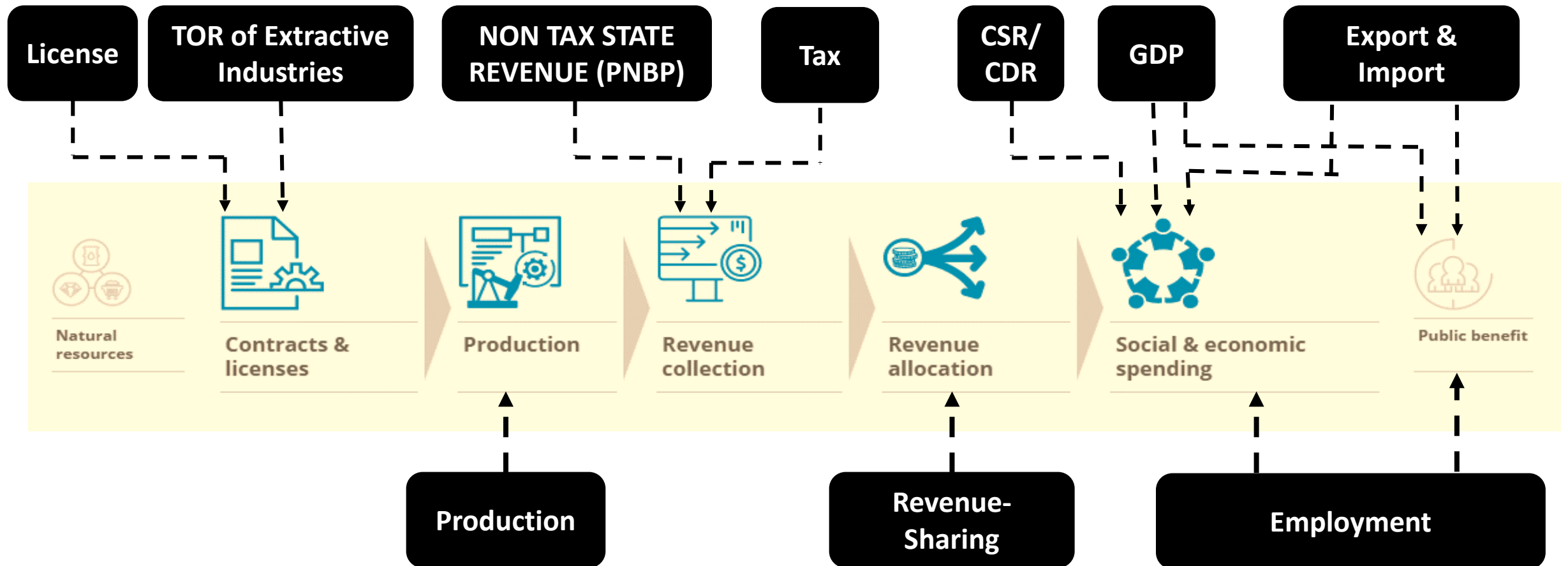
Objectives

- Disseminate and communicate various issues and substance contained in data portal to the wider society (Media, Academics, NGOs, Companies, etc.)
- Contribute to public discussions related to government policies for extractive industries
- Serve the user as a one-stop-shop platform that brings together all data in extractive industry value chain

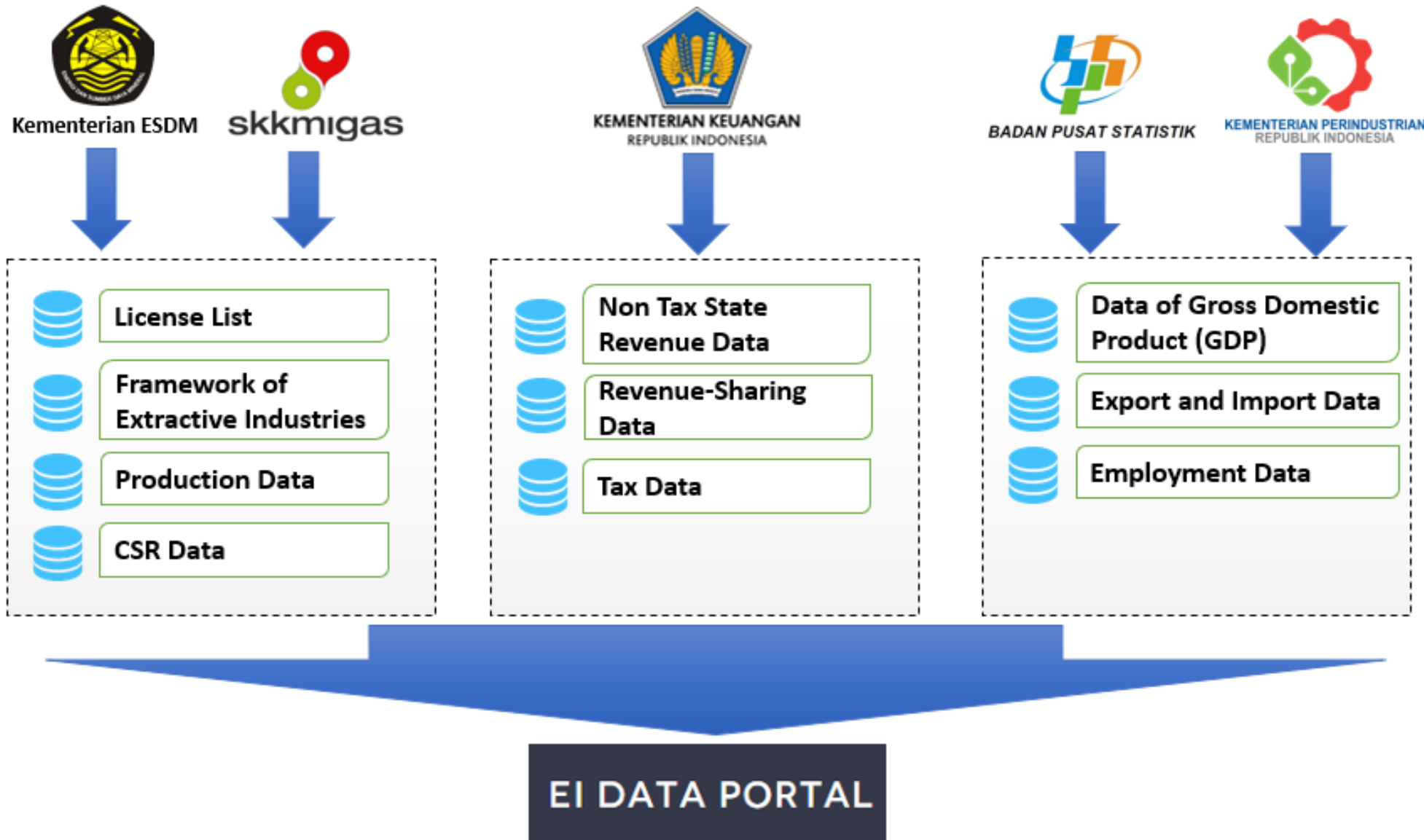
Milestone

The information contained includes per-company with detail information on the key steps in the governance of oil, gas and mining revenues

Oil and Gas Revenue

- Lifting Oil and Gas (Volume & Value)
- Domestic Market Obligation (DMO) Fee
- Over/Under Lifting
- Signature Bonus
- Corporate & Dividend Tax
- Production Bonus
